Artist and educator Barbara Wallace will be leading this *free* beginner's workshop series. The sessions, which include concept development, armature, forming, and finishing, will be hands-on with each participant creating their own artwork to take home at the end of the third session.



All supplies will be available, however, it is suggested that each participant bring some recycled materials, such as a wire hanger, small cardboard with smooth surfaces (i.e., cereal boxes), and magazines for tearing.

The ancient art of papier-mâché is a 3-D art technique originating in China as far back as the Han Dynasty. Today, the technique enjoys the status of a fine arts sculpture medium, often existing in large scale and complex artworks.
