PCCC's Auto-CAD Certificate Program Approved for Funding By New State Scholarship for Women and Minorities

The Auto-CAD Certificate of Achievement Program at Passaic County Community College was recently approved for funding by a new state scholarship program, **NJ GIVS (Governors Industry Vocations Scholarship) for Women and Minorities.**

The scholarship is for qualifying female and male or female minority students pursuing a degree or certificate in a construction-related field.

The NJ GIVS scholarship pays up to \$2000 per year or up to the cost of tuition for eligible students enrolled in an approved certificate program. The funding is limited and awards are made on a first-come, first-served basis.
