About Rowan University |

Rowan University is a public school in Glassboro, N.J., with a branch in Camden, N.J., that offers bachelor's through doctoral programs. In 2012, Rowan introduced a School of Biomedical Sciences and opened the first new M.D.-granting medical school in New Jersey in more than 35 years, Camden-based Cooper Medical School of Rowan University, in conjunction with Cooper University Health Care. In July 2013, Rowan included what is now known as the School of Osteopathic Medicine, in Stratford, making it only the second university in the nation with two medical schools. Rowan is slated to collaborate with Rutgers-Camden to create a College of Health Sciences in Camden. Recently designated by the State as only the second comprehensive public research institution in New Jersey, Rowan also includes the Rohrer College of Business and colleges of Communication and Creative Arts, Education, Engineering, Graduate and Continuing Education, Humanities and Social Sciences, Performing Arts, and Science and Mathematics.

About CSM |

Established in 2012, The College of Science and Mathematics provides new forward-looking professional and science programs that will make our graduates competitive in the job market. Our faculty engage in cross disciplinary collaborations and interdisciplinary teaching as well as research. Our students have opportunities for multidisciplinary majors that combine expertise and knowledge from seven different departments that offer a wide variety of discipline-specific and interdisciplinary undergraduate and graduate degree programs ranging from pure mathematics to biochemistry, applied behavior analysis and software engineering.

Infrastructure |

CSM is housed in three buildings – Robinson Hall, Science Hall and the Enterprise Center. Science Hall features state-of-the-art research and teaching labs, planetarium, observatory and greenhouse. Robinson Hall includes numerous classrooms, computer science teaching and research labs and psychology's experimental lab. The mixed-use Enterprise Center, a new addition to downtown Rowan, houses the nursing department.

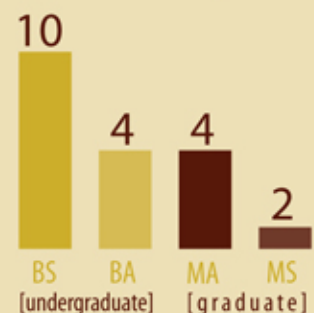
Funds & Grants |

Over \$1.7 million in external funding was received from 24 approved grants with CSM faculty as PIs. Some of the awarding agencies include NSF, NIH, MSE, FAA, NJ Governor's Council on Autism and Bristol-Myers Squibb.
