#### PCCC Registration Requirements:

- Must have completed the ESL002, ESL003 or ESL004 classes or
- Currently enrolled in Intermediate or Advanced ESL classes.
- English is your native language or you are proficient in English

#### Naturalization Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must produce a 1551 Alien Registration Card as proof of status
- Must have resided continuously as a lawful, permanent resident in the U.S. for 5 years prior to filing, with absences totaling no more than one year
- Must have resided within the State of New Jersey for at least 3 months
- Must be of good moral character
- Must be able to read, write, speak, and understand words in ordinary usage of the English language

Through this grant-funded program, Passaic County Community College offers instruction that provides students with language skills and civics knowledge needed to attain U.S. citizenship. The citizenship class helps you gain the skills you need to pass the citizenship exam. Help is available for those who need to apply with INS (Immigration & Naturalization Services).
