The average and median age of PCCC students in Fall 2020 was below the national mean and average (28 and 24 years old, respectively)



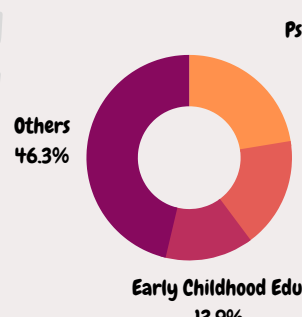
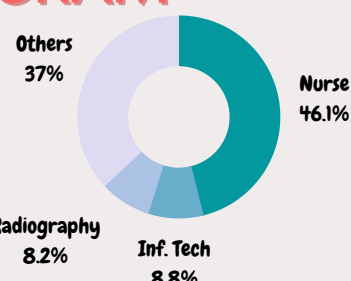
In Fall 2020, the top five majors for full-time students were Business Administration, Nurse Education, Biology, Criminal Justice, and Psychology.

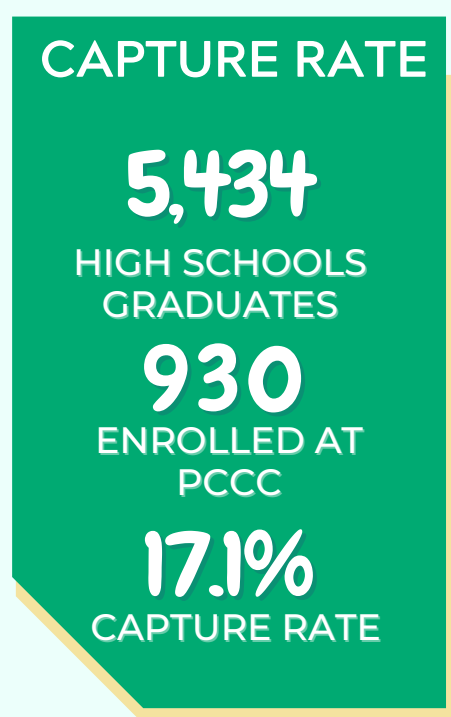

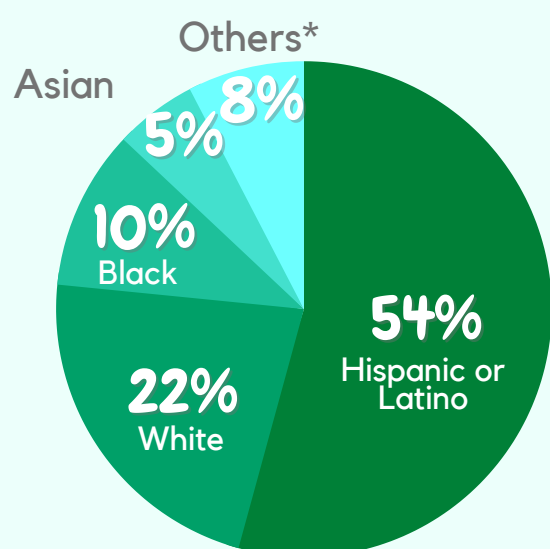

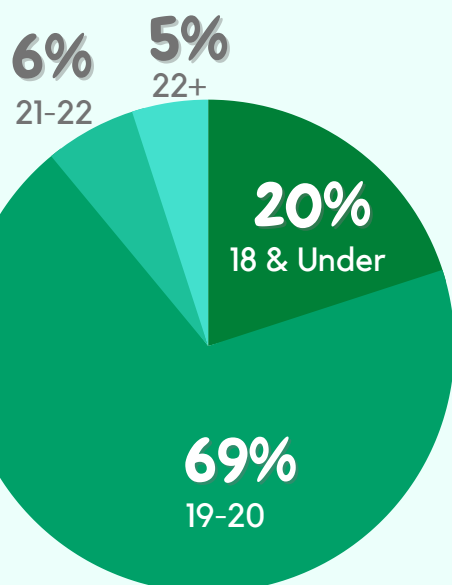

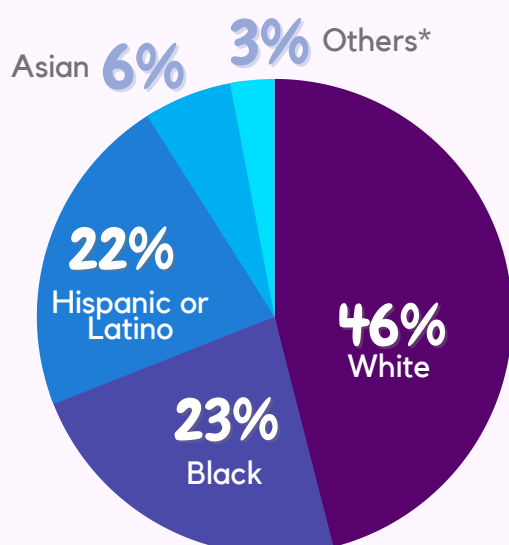

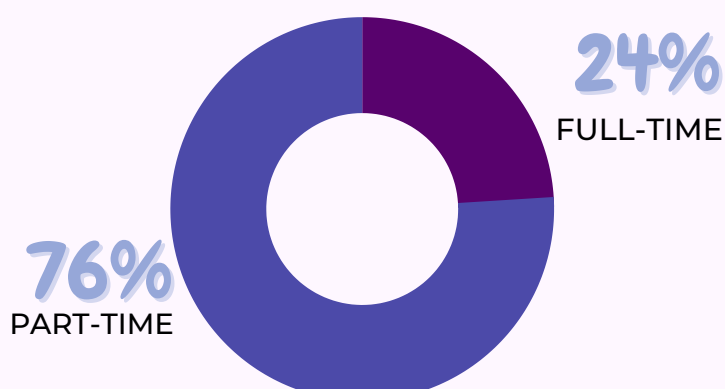

While full-time faculty showed a slight reduction of **4%** (from 86 to 82 employees), part-time instructional employees decreased by **20%** (from 333 to 266)

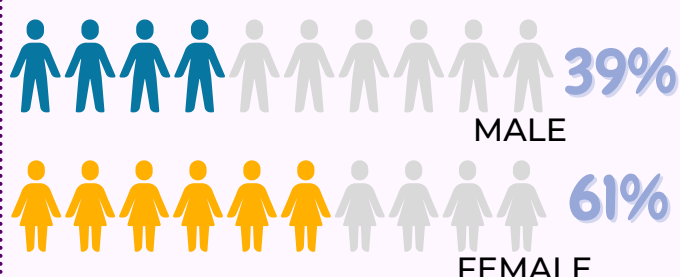

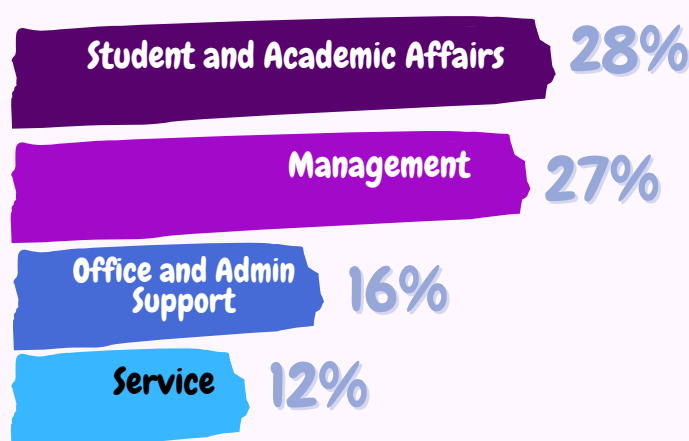

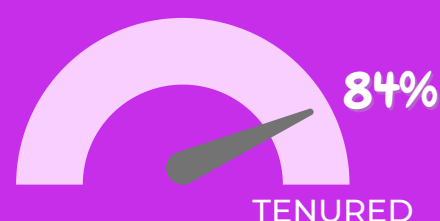
