WHOLE PROGRAMS OF STUDY

■ 15 to Finish

Too many of our students are not taking advantage of the benefits of full-time study. Too many are not following the curriculum.

We propose we:

- Give student better tools for following their programs
- Educate students regarding the benefits of taking 15 credits
- Educate students on services available to assist them when they are FT
- Offer financial incentives for full-time study
- Offer more credit-bearing certificates

EXCESS/WASTED CREDITS

Nationally students graduate with more credits than they need for the degree. Looking at the PCCC 2014 graduating class, on average

- AA students graduated with 10.2 extra
- AS students graduated with 14.4 extra
- AAS graduated with 18.4 extra

Since PCCC requires COL-103 (previously COL-102) all students will graduate with an extra 1 or 2 credits

PCCC has a list of courses a student may take while in Developmental/ESL. For the majority of programs, these courses are not applicable to a degree. We want to see a purpose for each course.
