### **CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES –May 17, 2022**

Chairman Marco asked if there were any corrections to the minutes for May 17, 2022. Hearing none, Trustee Nutter moved Resolution #1 – Consideration of Minutes for the May 17, 2022, board meeting; seconded by Trustee Montanez-Diodonet. Upon roll call, Resolution #1 passed with Trustee Akhter “abstaining” and all other members present voting “yes.”

### **PRESENTATION: Strategic Priorities**

President Rose was pleased to present the Strategic Priorities to the Board, which was the next phase in the development of the Strategic Plan. He recalled that the first part was the revising of the Mission Statement for the College, which was approved at the May 17, 2022 Board of Trustees meeting.

A total of four major goals were presented, as follows:

- (1) Increase student completion through data analysis and high impact practices;
- (2) Strengthen community engagement and partnerships within PCCC Community;
- (3) Provide innovative academic programs and training that meet the current and future needs of students, employers, and the community;
- (4) Enrich the student experience.

Listed within these four major goals were specific initiatives. These initiatives would drive budget planning for the next several years. President Rose noted too that the Executive Committee of the Board recommended that a Retreat be held in the fall to fully discuss each goal.

\_\_\_\_(7) *Matters Relating to Litigation, Negotiations and the Attorney-Client Privilege:* Any pending or anticipated litigation or contract negotiation in which the public body is, or may become a party. Any matters falling within the attorney-client privilege, to the extent that confidentiality is require in order for the attorney to exercise his ethical duties as a lawyer.

\_\_\_\_(8) *Matters Relating to the Employment Relationship:* Any matter involving the employment, appointment, termination of employment, terms and conditions of employment, evaluation of the performance of promotion or disciplining of any specific prospective public officer or employee or current public officer or employee employed or appointed by the public body, unless all the individual employees or appointees whose rights could be adversely affected request in writing that such matter or matters be discussed at a public meeting.

\_\_\_\_(9) *Matters Relating to the Potential Imposition of a Penalty:* Any deliberations of a public body occurring after a public hearing that may result in the imposition of a specific civil penalty upon the responding party or the suspension or loss of a license or permit belonging to the responding party bears responsibility.


