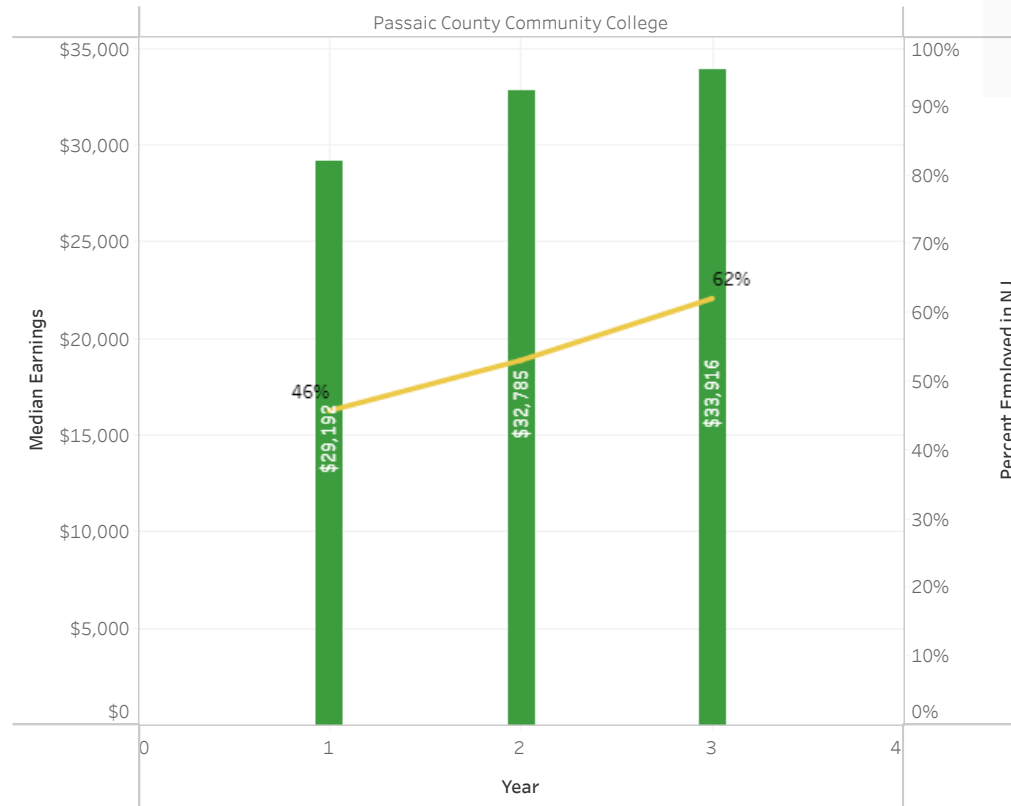

Notes: Earnings are inflation adjusted to the third quarter of 2021. Data are presented for graduates of New Jersey colleges and universities participating in the Student Unit Record (SURE) data collection.

Employment is measured using state Unemployment Insurance (UI) wage records, which capture the employment experiences of most in-state employees, including all employees of private firms participating in the UI program, but excluding non-participating federal, military, agricultural, and self-employed workers. For calculation of annualized wages from the quarterly data, only wages that were equal or higher than the full-time equivalent of the state minimum wage threshold for the corresponding year were included.
