The following are the minutes of the Board of Trustees of Passaic County Community College, held on December 19, 2023, at 6:00 p.m., at Passaic County Community College, 1 College Boulevard, Paterson, NJ. The public was invited to attend, per the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6.

### **CALL TO ORDER**

Chairman Marco called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m., and then asked everyone to join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

President Rose stated pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this meeting was given in the annual meeting notice, which was emailed to the Record-News Herald, the Office of the County Clerk, and posted on the PCCC Website and bulletin boards on November 28, 2023.

### **CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES – November 21, 2023**

Chairman Marco asked if there were any corrections to the minutes, and hearing none, the minutes were approved with Trustee Moody making the motion and Trustee Po giving a second. Upon roll call, Resolution #1 passed with all members present voting “yes.”

### **PRESENTATIONS**

#### **Donohue, Gironda, Doria, and Tompkins, LLC Audit Report**

President Rose stated the first presentation would be from our auditors and that the Budget, Audit and Finance Committee met prior to this meeting and received an extended presentation on the audit.

VP Hardy introduced Mauricio Canto and Julisa Smith from Donohue, Gironde, Doria, and Tompkins, LLC. Mr. Canto stated they were giving a “clean opinion” of the financial statements, and there were no findings to report to the Board as well as no discussions about disagreements with management that escalated to the report. He also explained how well the College managed its decrease in pandemic relief funds and that it reduced expenses to stabilize the operation of the College. Mr. Canto stated there is no concern about the College sustaining itself over the years. He concluded by stating that the audit went very smoothly and that this reflects well on the finance department and management of the College. There was a question on the overall fund balance for the College, and Mr. Canto stated they are very pleased with the College’s unrestricted surplus of \$21 million dollars. He further stated this is an approximate increase of \$1M from last year.

#### Middle States Update: Standard II. Ethics & Integrity

President Rose stated that tonight’s Middle States presentation would be on Standard II and turned it over to VP Kineavy who introduced the Middle States co-chairs, Dr. Dawn Norman, Meredith Behrens and Dr. Christine Waldeyer, as well as Standard II co-chairs, Professor Linda Carter and Janet Albrecht. The presentation started with a brief overview of important dates and the seven standards. With regards to Standard II specifically, it was explained that ethics and integrity are guiding principles and the hallmarks of us as educators, administrators, an institution of higher education and a community anchor institution. A brief summary of the College’s strengths and opportunities for improvement were discussed. President Rose added that this is a standard you don’t want to fail and explained that you want to make sure that what the College is saying to the public about themselves is accurate.

#### Social Media: #MyPCCC

President Rose stated this was touched on at the retreat, and there was a discussion about how the College gets itself out there and communicates with students. The presentation was then turned over to Dr. Rebecca Royal, Meredith Behrens and Ashley Castiglia. Dr. Royal began by stating that social media is a powerful and versatile tool to connect with students, prospective students and community members. Meredith added that it’s both a recruitment and retention tool and gave a brief overview of the social media platforms the College is currently using—Facebook, Instagram, X (formerly Twitter), YouTube and LinkedIn. She explained how our departments work well together and can collaborate even more effectively to reach more students and increase followers. Meredith also stated that it’s not “one size fits all” with social media and it’s important to utilize all platforms. Next Ashley reviewed the contents of the marketing welcome packet that was distributed and explained that the creative pieces match the “family feel” of PCCC and all pictures included are of our students. The presentation concluded with next steps for social media including expanded use of #hashtags, enhancing content and promoting PCCC at professional events. A brief question and answer then took place.

## **REPORTS**

President Rose gave background information on the board policy on the agenda. He explained that back in the 1980s, a decision was made to create a board policy stating that in order for a

student to graduate from the College, in addition to meeting all the requirements, passing all their courses and having the right number of credits, they had to pass a writing exam. This was a way to ensure to employers that students who graduated from the College had basic writing skills. When this started in the 1980s, a large percentage of students did not pass the exam on the first try. The College would help the students before they took it again, but some students would transfer to other schools without ever graduating; and this kept the College's graduation rate low. Then 20 years ago, one of the grants the College had was to deal with this problem so the College could get students up to a certain level and be able to eliminate the exam. Therefore, a Writing Intensive Course Program started requiring that students in transfer programs had to take at least two courses designated Writing Intensive. Over the years, there has been a steady increase in the number of students who passed the exam on the first try. In the past three years, it has been above 85% consistently; and the College always said that if it could get to a point where the vast majority of its students are passing this exam, the exam wouldn't be needed anymore. Thus, President Rose explained that the change in board policy being presented tonight would no longer require students to take the College Writing Exam prior to graduation.

VP Kineavy clarified that non-transfer Applied Science students only take one Writing Intensive course. She stated that a number of faculty are trained in teaching the Writing Intensive courses, and it's time for this exam to be deleted from being a graduation requirement.

A question was raised about students who have transferred from PCCC without taking this exam, and VP Kineavy said the College will be looking at this and getting a list of these students.

President Rose explained that this change went to Academic Council and was approved by the faculty and administration who all recommend this change happen at this point.

Trustee Pou asked about the purchase of office furniture for the Accounting Department. President Rose explained that the College's whole business area moved a few years ago to an entirely new space which was renovated and now needs to be furnished. Trustee Pou asked the number of people this was for and VP Hardy said 15-20 people including part-time staff.

Trustee Moody asked about the Men of Color Initiative Ceremony on President Rose's list of Significant Activities, and President Rose turned it over to VP Hardy as he is the leader of the group. VP Hardy explained the group was created as a support group for male-identifying



students and has an emphasis on mentoring, holds workshops for tutoring and life skills as well as other social events.

#### **A. POLICY MATTER – BOARD POLICY D401: GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

##### **D401 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

All requirements of the program in which the student matriculated, as stated in the current official copy of the College Catalog at the time of matriculation, must be met.

The granting of a degree from Passaic County Community College will require no less than sixty (60) college-level credits, with a minimum of thirty (30) credits completed at Passaic County Community College. Students must complete at least one-half of the credits in the major at Passaic County Community College. Students intending to graduate must notify the Registrar.

~~To graduate, students must successfully pass the College Writing Examination (CWE). Students with a bachelor degree or higher from a regionally accredited college or university in the United States, or former Passaic County Community College graduates returning for another degree are exempt from taking the College Writing Examination (CWE). Students with a bachelor's degree or higher, earned outside the United States, are required to take the College Writing Examination.~~

~~Former Passaic County Community College students applying for Reverse Transfer are exempt from taking the College Writing Examination (CWE), but must transfer equivalent courses from another college or university.~~

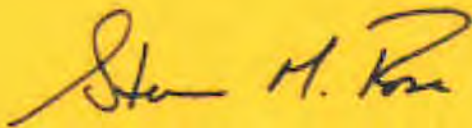
