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The following are the minutes for the Board of Trustees of Passaic County Community College online meeting held on February 26, 2024 at 6:00 p.m. via the Zoom web-based meeting service. The public was invited to attend, per the Open Public Meetings Act, N.J.S.A. 10:4-6.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Marco called the meeting to order at 6:02 p.m., and then asked everyone to join him in the Pledge of Allegiance.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETINGS ACT ANNOUNCEMENT

President Rose stated pursuant to the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of this meeting was given in the Revised Annual Meeting Notice, which was emailed to the Record-News Herald, the Office of the County Clerk, and posted on the PCCC Website and bulletin boards on February 15, 2024.

CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES - January 16, 2024

Chairman Marco asked if there were any corrections to the minutes, and hearing none, the minutes were approved with Trustee Glovin making the motion and Trustee Ramirez giving a second. Upon roll call, Resolution #1 passed with all members present voting "yes."

B. PERSONNEL ITEMS

President Rose stated we have been working on the energy savings plan for a long time. He turned it over to Legal Counsel Cerone who explained we've had an energy audit, an industrial energy audit, worked with PSE&G on the direct install, had a plan reviewed by a 3rd party reviewer and made changes, and the plan was approved by the Board of Public Utilities at the end of December. He further explained that there are three resolutions to adopt in regards to the energy savings plan: the actual energy savings plan approval itself, the financing for the plan, and approving the contract with Schneider Electric.

Trustee Glovin asked about the timeline going forward, inquiring how long the work will take from when the plan starts. Legal Counsel Cerone asked Dan Riggle from Schneider Electric to address this question. Dan explained that the contract term is two years but the majority of work should be done during 2024, this calendar year. Legal Counsel Cerone further stated that the Board of School Estimate is meeting tomorrow and one of the resolutions on their agenda is to move forward with the funding plan with the County of Passaic.

Trustee Glovin also asked when the work would start. Dan said April/May is when we may start to see physical work happening on campus. Legal Counsel Cerone added that we need the County to pass their bond ordinance before we can commit and that we have a 90-day window in the contract with Schneider.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

No Executive Session was held.

ACTION ITEMS AGENDA - Resolution #3 - Consent Resolution Items A through C

Resolution #3 was moved by Vice Chair Tanis and seconded by Trustee Pou. Upon roll call, Resolution #3 passed with all members present voting "yes."

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of Passaic County Community College, upon the recommendation of the President, hereby approves the following actions:

A. ENERGY SAVINGS PLAN

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PASSAIC COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE APPROVING AN ENERGY SAVINGS PLAN

WHEREAS, the Passaic County Community College (the "College") had energy audits of the College facilities conducted pursuant to the Local Government Energy Audit Program, and such audits were completed and delivered to the College; and

WHEREAS, the College has determined to consider the implementation of an energy savings improvement program pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:65A-1 and to seek the assistance of an energy services company (an "Energy Services Company") for assistance with the development and implementation of an energy savings plan; and

WHEREAS, the College selected Schneider Electric Buildings America, Inc. ("Schneider Electric") as its Energy Services Company to assist the College with its energy savings program; and

WHEREAS, Schneider Electric has worked with the representatives of the College to develop an energy savings plan and has presented the proposed plan to the College; and

WHEREAS, the College hired Concord Energy Services, a qualified independent third party (the "Verification Agent"), to verify that the projected energy savings to be realized from the proposed program has been calculated as required by law, the Verification Agent has issued its report to this effect, the report and proposed plan have been submitted to the Board of Public Utilities for review, and the Board of Public Utilities has approved the proposed plan on December 29, 2023; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the proposed plan, the College has determined that the energy savings generated from reduced energy use from the energy conservation measures set Board of Trustees Meeting February 26, 2024 Page 4 of 18

forth in the proposed energy savings plan will be sufficient to cover the cost of the energy conservation measures described in the proposed energy savings plan and that it is in the best interest of the College to approve, adopt and implement the proposed energy savings plan for the College pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:65A-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PASSAIC COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Energy Savings Plan submitted by Schneider Electric and developed with the professional staff of the College, to be dated as of December 29, 2023, or as otherwise determined by the College (the "Energy Savings Plan"), is hereby approved and adopted as the Energy Savings Plan of the College.

Section 2. The Board Secretary is hereby directed to arrange to have the Energy Savings Plan submitted to the Board of Public Utilities for posting on its website and to post the Energy Savings Plan on the College's website in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:65A-1(d)(4).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

B. ENERGY SAVINGS IMPROVEMENTS THROUGH THE ISSUANCE OF ENERGY SAVINGS OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS AND OTHER FUNDING SOURCES

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PASSAIC COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE DETERMINING TO RAISE MONEY FOR ENERGY SAVINGS IMPROVEMENTS THROUGH THE ISSUANCE OF ENERGY SAVINGS OBLIGATION REFUNDING BONDS AND OTHER FUNDING SOURCES

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Passaic County Community College (the "Board") has determined pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-19 that it is necessary to raise funds and to sell

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energy savings obligation refunding bonds to raise money for certain energy savings improvements in the estimated amounts described in the Statement attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined to deliver the attached Statement to each member of the Board of School Estimate to request them to fix and determine the amount necessary for the projects as set forth therein and to certify such amount to this Board of Trustees and to the County of Passaic, New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-19;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PASSAIC COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE, as follows:

Section 1. This Board of Trustees hereby determines that it is necessary to raise funds in the amount of \$21,315,000 and to sell energy savings obligation refunding bonds to raise money in an amount not to exceed \$10,500,000 for the projects described in the Statement attached hereto and to utilize approximately \$6,000,000 available Chapter 12 funds and \$4,815,000 available as a capital contribution.

Section 2. The Board Secretary is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this resolution and the Statement attached hereto to each member of the Board of School Estimate and to request them to fix and determine the amount necessary for the projects as set forth therein and to certify such amount to this Board of Trustees and to the County of Passaic, New Jersey pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-19.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The Board of Trustees of the Passaic County Community College has determined and states pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:64A-19 that it is necessary to raise money for the capital purposes in the estimated amounts aggregating not to exceed \$21,315,000 including financing, work,

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materials and incidental costs, as described below, through the sale of energy savings obligation refunding bonds in an amount not expected to exceed \$10,500,000, together with not to exceed \$6,000,000 available from Chapter 12 bond proceeds and \$4,815,000 available from capital reserve:

Purpose and Amount Needed for Project

Energy conservation measure improvements and related work and costs, which shall include the improvements listed below and described in more detail in the Passaic County Community College approved energy savings plan, dated as of December 29, 2023 (the "Project").

The total cost of the Project shall not exceed \$21,315,000 and will be funded by: (1) Chapter 12 funding in the approximate amount not to exceed \$6,000,000; (2) capital contribution in the approximate amount not to exceed of \$4,815,000; and (3) energy savings obligation refunding bonds in an amount not to exceed \$10,500,000.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PASSAIC COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH SCHNEIDER ELECTRIC TO IMPLEMENT ENERGY SAVINGS PLAN

WHEREAS, the Passaic County Community College (the "College") has approved an Energy Savings Plan submitted by Schneider Electric and developed with the professional staff of the College, dated as of December 29, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the College has determined that it should enter into a construction contract

with Schneider Electric to implement the Energy Saving Plan approved by the College.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF

PASSAIC COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The College shall enter into a contract with Schneider Electric Buildings Americas, Inc. for the purposes of doing the work necessary to implement the Energy Savings Plan upon such terms and conditions as are set forth in an agreement between the parties as annexed hereto.

Section 2. The Chair of the Board of Trustees and the President of the College are hereby authorized to execute the contract with Schneider Electric.
